Age requirements are in accordance to the Donegal / Rheems Softball League. Please use one form per team. Limited to 10 teams in the 14 A & 14 B Divisions.

## **Tournament Rules:**

1. Rosters for non Donegal/Rheems league teams must be turned in prior to the first game of play in tournament. The roster shall consist of the player's name, date of birth and uniform number. Coaches shall also be listed.
2. All teams shall be ready to play 15 minutes prior to their start time. A forfeit will occur if the team is not present at game time.
3. Only designated coaches and bookkeeper's are permitted in the bench area.
4. Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their respective spectators. If a spectator from your team is ejected from the playing field, it is the coach's responsibility to remove the individual. A forfeit of the game will occur if spectator is not removed in a timely matter.
5. Only the coaching staff may approach the umpiring staff to discuss rule violations during the playing of the games.
6. Anyone ejected from the game ( players, coaches, spectators ) will be suspended for one game and can not be present on the playing field and immediate area.
7. Practice will not be allowed on the **football field, or batting cage** during the tournament. Failure to follow this rule can lead to ejection from tournament.
9. The games are in accordance to Donegal / Rheems age groups. A coin toss prior to each game will determine home team.
10. The 10 run rule is effect for all tournament games. The game will be over after the completion 4<sup>th</sup> inning for PeeWee and 5<sup>th</sup> inning for all others. If the home team is winning by 10 or more runs in the bottom of the 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> inning, the game is over. The home team is required to bat, if behind, before game is called per this rule.
11. The tournament will revert to Donegal / Rheems Softball League rules, then ASA rules, if not stated in this rules section. Run limits as stated in Donegal / Rheems rules are in effect.
12. Awards will be presented to the top two teams of each age bracket at the end of the championship game.
13. Time limit per game will be 1hour and 45 minutes.
